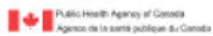

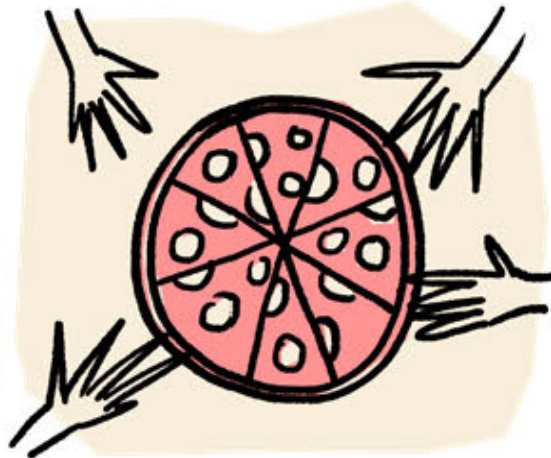


DO PEOPLE EVER MISJUDGE YOU BASED ON WHAT YOU LOOK LIKE?
